

Regulation

on Editorial Board of the International Electronic Scientific and Practical Journal «WayScience»

I. General

1. The founder of the International Electronic Scientific and Practical Journal «WayScience» (hereinafter - the journal) is FOP Marenichenko V.V. (hereinafter - the founder).

2. The editorial board of the journal (hereinafter - the editorial board) - a collegial body that determines editorial policy for objective coverage of the scientific research results of Ukrainian and foreign authors in the journal.

3. The Editorial Board operates in accordance with the legislation of Ukraine and the Regulation on the Editorial Board of the International Electronic Scientific and Practical Journal «WayScience» (hereinafter - Regulation).

4. This Regulation defines the procedure for establishment and composition of the editorial board, the powers of the editor-in-chief, the rights and responsibilities of its members.

5. The editor-in-chief and members of the editorial board are elected for an indefinite period until one of the parties (founder or editor-in-chief (members of the editorial board)) notifies the other party of the termination of participation in the editorial board in writing form (or scanned version in electronic form).

II. Procedure of establishment and composition of the editorial board

1. The editorial board is established to carry out activities on the functioning of the journal, which, in particular, provides quality independent review if necessary and at the request of the editor-in-chief of materials submitted for publication by scientists conducting research in a particular specialty.

2. The editorial board consisting of the editor-in-chief and its members and is created in accordance with the decision of the founder of the Journal.

III. Powers of the editor-in-chief

1. Organizes the work of the editorial board in accordance to this Regulation.
2. Convenes meetings of the editorial board (if necessary), determines the place, time of their holding and chairs them.
3. Provides meeting proposals to the founder of the Journal, who makes a decision on the possibility of their implementation.
4. Initiates the issue of suspension or inclusion of a member of the editorial board to founder of the Journal.
5. Instructs members of the editorial board to review (requests for review by scholars who are not members of the editorial board) author's publications.
6. Determines the procedure and timing of reviewing author's publications.
7. Based on the results of the review, makes proposals to include peer-reviewed articles in the regular issues of the Journal.

IV. Rights and responsibilities of the editorial board members

1. Members of the editorial board have the rights:
 - make proposals for changes and additions to this Regulation;
 - make suggestions on activities of the Journal;
 - free of charge once a year to publish an article in the next issue of the Journal.
2. Members of the editorial board have the responsibilities:
 - to review (if necessary and at the request of the editor-in-chief) author's publications depending on the defined scientific specialty;
 - to provide in writing (or scanned versions in electronic form) (if necessary and at the request of the editor-in-chief) reviews of peer-reviewed articles with a mandatory indication of their recommendation for publication; the need for refinement or rejection;
 - to be a member of the organizing committee (if necessary) in the events held by the journal (conferences, scientific forums, discussions, symposia, trainings, etc.).
